

Deep Cove BBQ

Wednesday, June 17th is our annual **Deep Cove Year End Potluck BBQ**. It will be a fun and sunny farewell for Principal Moser and also a chance to meet our new Principal, Grant Franceschini, who will be attending. This year, for the first time we are also holding “**Kid Kiosks**” where students are invited to *display or sell* their creations collections or talents. In order to participate in the kiosks, students must **SIGN UP** on the sheets posted in their classrooms - the deadline to sign up is FRIDAY, JUNE 12th. The kiosks are intended to showcase student interests and creativity, and the criteria are:

“Make it! Bake it! Grow it! or Show it!”

Kid Kiosks:

- The kiosk area will be the infront of the school between the 2 playgrounds, and will be open for business & browsing between 5pm-7pm. Students can set up starting at 4:30pm.
- Each student will be randomly given one half of a table, so 2 students will share a rectangular folding table. This is their “kiosk” and they are responsible for that space.
- Students are also given a poster board (on Friday) to bring home and decorate as they wish and display on the front of their table. It should specify the name of their item and whether it is a “display” or include a price if their items are “for sale”.
- If their items are for sale, students should be prepared to count cash, make change, and securely store their own float.
- Students can keep their profits to save for something important or donate to a favourite cause.
- Kiosks should not be left unattended, so if students need to leave their kiosk for any reason (ie. use the washroom), they should have someone replace them while they are gone.
- At 7pm, students will be asked to pack up their kiosk, stack their chairs and folding tables next to the front entrance.

Potluck BBQ:

- Families & staff are invited to attend 5-8pm on the soccer field.
- Live music 5-8pm by “Knacker’s Yard”.
- Potluck tables will be set up against the school across from the swings.
- Please bring a potluck salad or dessert to share and a serving spoon or utensil (label your things).
- Bring your own beverages, plates and cutlery, chairs & blankets, meat for BBQ.
- Please bring a portable BBQ if you have one, and tools.
- Bring your kites, bubble wands, soccer balls, and cameras.
- Students can enter a draw to win school t-shirts from the PAC.
- Washrooms will be available inside the front entrance.
- Bring your loonies and toonies for the Kid Kiosks!
